CHAPTER 1: Introduction

According to Eme et al, (2012) town unions represent anassociation formed by the people of the same town, local government or evendistrict as the case may be. 1.1Background of the Study

and inadequate housing poor lighting particularly at night, defeatist/fatalist attitude, small land parcel ownership, out-modeled ineffective farming implement etc. these conditions cannot be ameliorated by governmentalone.

The importance of the community development in contemporaryNigerian society cannot be overemphasized as much as it cannot be relegated to the background as its significance stems from its recognized role in the process of achieving the improvement of economic, social, political and cultural conditions of the communities.
